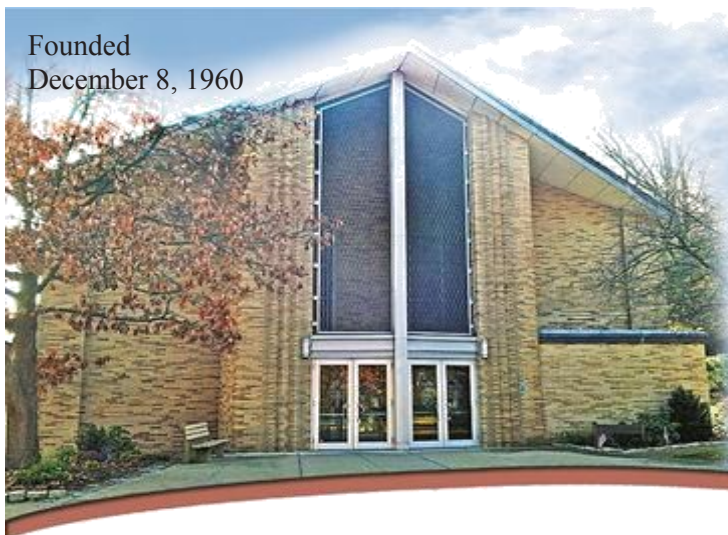

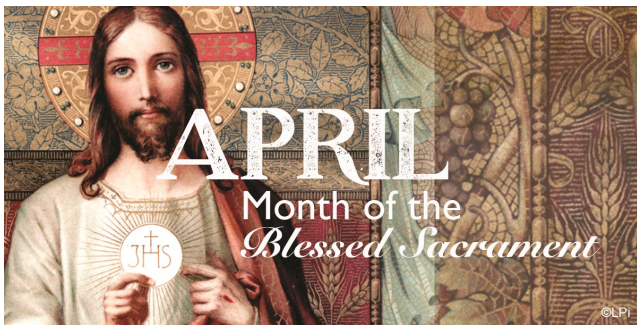

## FROM THE DESK OF FATHER RICHARD . . .

### RESTORE, REPAIR & RENEW

As we draw nearer to the merger of our two parishes this summer, many parishioners continue to support our efforts as we restore, repair and renew our church properties and grounds that will serve the more than 8,000 people who will come together to worship God for years to come. I'd like to provide you with two recent examples of how our parishioners' generosity enabled us to make necessary improvements to enhance the liturgical, educational and social mission of our community. The first is sacred; the second practical.

At St. Winifred Parish, we recently restored two chalices, which had been given to the parish years ago, as well as added two new candle posts for the altar. Within a couple of weeks of our appeal, three parish families came forward to cover the cost of these sacred vessels and furnishings to enhance our worship. We've been using the new candle posts for the past few months, and will begin to use the restored chalices in Holy Week, on Holy Thursday and Easter Sunday. The chalices had originally been donated to St. Winifred by the Cicero, Teolis and Vacca families, one in memory of living and deceased family members; the other, in memory of Bonnie Cybolski. The generous donations of **Al and Kathleen Hamel, Chris and Janice Caruso** and an anonymous donor enabled us to restore or purchase these expensive vessels and furnishings to enhance the liturgy and preserve the patrimony of St. Winifred Parish.

At St. Anne Parish, we recently had to make some practical improvements in the school kitchen because some of the mechanical systems were worn out and needed replaced or repaired. The double-door freezer needed a new compressor, the exhaust fans had to be repaired, one of the deep fryers was replaced, a new commercial garbage disposal was installed and we purchased a new commercial dish washer. We made these necessary improvements to upgrade our facilities and help the volunteers who work the school meals, the Lenten fish fries and the summer festival. Several St. Anne parishioners helped in these practical improvements. **Rudy Richter** identified the needs in the kitchen and arranged for the repairs and replacements. **Sonny Raso, Chuck McGervey, John Collins and Don Hillebrand** generously donated or installed or repaired the kitchen appliances for our community.

The point of this column is not only to inform you about the valuable improvements completed at both parishes and the school, but also to let you know about the generosity of your fellow parishioners who support the works of St. Winifred and St. Anne, whether through the original donation of the chalices, the donations to restore these sacred vessels and purchase of new furnishings for the altar, or the overhauling of dated mechanical systems and appliances in the school kitchen, we rely on your thoughtful support to restore and repair our parishes for both sacred and practical purposes. Thank you for your gracious support of St. Winifred and St. Anne parishes as we draw closer to our summer merger in the hope of spiritual renewal.
