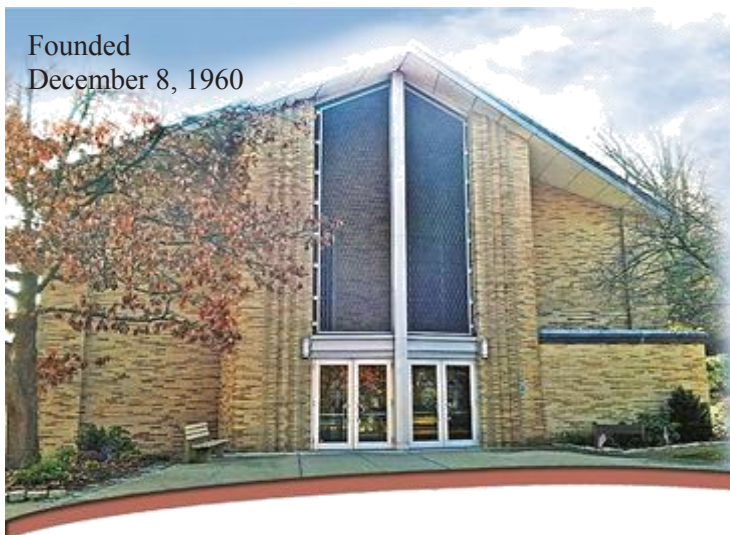

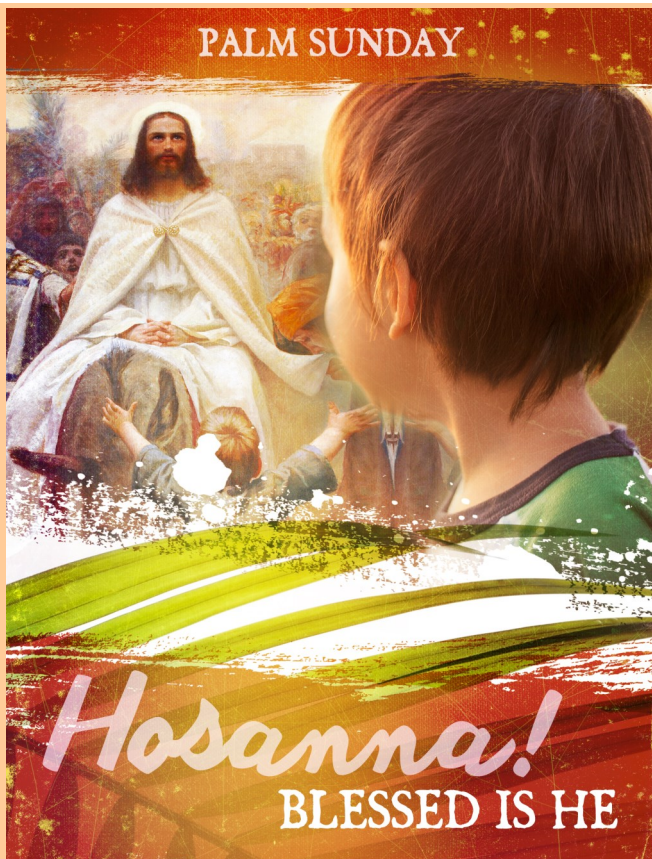

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER MIKE . . .

HOLY WEEK 2019

Palm Sunday is our entrance into the most sacred week of the Church's liturgical year. The beautiful ceremonies of Holy Week are not to be mere recollections or dramatizations of past events; rather the liturgical celebrations of Christ's passion, death and resurrection are "memorials" in the fullest sense of that term. This means that the ceremonies of Holy Week actually *make present* the events of that first Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday in Jerusalem. In other words, Jesus will suffer, die and rise again through our sacramental celebrations of Holy Week and Easter.

Therefore, today we go up to Jerusalem with Jesus to hail Him as our sovereign Lord and King. On Thursday evening we will gather with Him in the Upper Room at Jerusalem as He institutes the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar. Further, in a very real sense we will be present in that Cenacle as He ordains His first priests, so that Christ's saving ministry will never be absent from our lives. On Good Friday, we will accompany our Lord on His Way of the Cross and stand with His mother Mary at the foot of the cross, knowing that our sins have caused such agony. But on Easter Sunday we will glory in the knowledge that Christ has risen, sin and death have been defeated, and our redemption has been accomplished.

May this truly be a Holy Week for our parish family. And may we all step back from the hectic pace of life for just one week and dedicate this week to contemplate what Jesus has done for us, and what He continues to do for us today!
