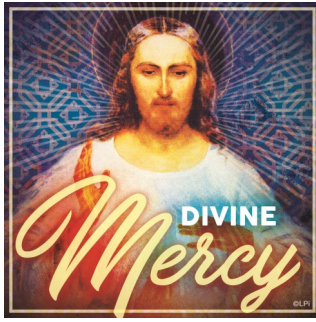

Acts 5:27-32 Revelation 5:11-14 John 21:1-19

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER RICHARD . . .

Today, we celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter (or Sunday of Divine Mercy). Pope St. John Paul II established this octave Sunday as Divine Mercy Sunday on April 30, 2000 when he canonized Sister Faustina Kowalska as the first saint of the Great Jubilee Year. Her canonization and establishment of Divine Mercy Sunday followed 67 years of revelatory visions, church investigations, 20 years of dormancy in her cause for sainthood, the election of Cardinal Karol Wojtyla, the Archbishop of Krakow, to the Chair of Peter as Pope John Paul II, and the resuscitation and affirmation of her cause and visions shortly thereafter. Sister Faustina's life of holiness and vision of God's divine mercy were declared heroic by the Church on March 7, 1992. Following a healing attributed to her intercession, Sister Faustina was declared Blessed, or beatified, the necessary step before her eventual canonization as the first saint of the new millennium by Pope John Paul II.

Both before and after her canonization in 2000 A.D., devotion to St. Faustina and the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy enjoyed widespread participation among the Catholic faithful in Poland, Italy, the United States and countries throughout the world. With the establishment of this Sunday of Divine Mercy on the octave of Easter 19 years ago, a **special Holy Hour will be offered at St. Anne Church this Sunday beginning at 3:00 p.m.** The Holy Hour will include the Chaplet and Litany of Divine Mercy, St. Faustina's vision of Christ, and Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament. We invite our parish families from St. Anne and St. Winifred and beyond, to complete the Octave of Easter with this Holy Hour in celebration of God's Divine Mercy given to us in Jesus Christ.

Additionally, thirteen young people will make their First Holy Communion at the 10:00 a.m. Mass this Sunday at St. Winifred Church. Please pray in support of this important sacramental moment in the lives of these children, their families and our parish community.

Thank you to all the volunteers and staff who helped make our celebration of Holy Week, Easter and the Octave such a joyful event at both St. Winifred and St. Anne Parishes. From the wonderful music to the beautiful floral decorations, from the full Masses to your generous donations, our celebration of the Paschal Mystery has been a graceful joy for all who believe in God's merciful love.
